Fellowship Community is located 1 block north of the intersection of Arapahoe Rd. and South Parker Rd.

From the North or South take Arapahoe Rd. East off of I-25 approximately 4.5 miles to South Parker Rd. Turn left and go 1 block to the next traffic signal. Turn left at the traffic signal, then right into the parking lot of Fellowship Community.

You can also access South Parker from I-225, Exit #4. Go South for approximately 4.75 miles, the church will be on the right. If you pass the church, simply turn right at the next traffic signal, then right into the church parking lot.

What to expect...
