Session 1 Why Rest Matters (Exodus 20:8-11, Genesis 2)

What is Sabbath? How does rest reflect the image of God? Why don't we do it?

Session 2 Rest to Reconnect and Relinquish (Matthew 11:28-30)

Trusting Jesus sounds good, but how do we actually do it? In order to find rest, we must come to Jesus and relinquish control.

Session 4 The Rest is yet to come. (Hebrews 4 and various passages)

How do we work toward rest in practical ways for our self, our family, and our church? Do we look forward to the ultimate rest in heaven for eternity? If heaven is our home how does that help us to endure the unrestful times and seasons in our lives?
