**8:00 AM** Saddle up Parkview EFC/Rapid City, Wall EFC, Kadoka, Crossroads/Custer. End in Hot Springs

300 Miles, 5.5 hours saddle time

#### Thursday, July 29

**8:00 AM** Saddle Up Hot Springs, SD EFC, Monument, CO
