OUR MISSION

Serving our churches and our pastors to multiply God's Kingdom.

OUR VISION

To resource our churches for intentional evangelism and discipleship.

To resource our mission and vision, the District Leadership Team has approved the use of up to \$40,000 a year to be used as 4 to 1 matching grants of up to \$4000 per church in the district.

Each proposal must show how the funds will be used to further evangelism or discipleship in an existing local community.

EACH GRANT PROPOSAL MUST INCLUDE:

- An explanation of the proposed grant need and the ongoing impact within the church or community as it relates to Discipleship or Evangelism.
- A correlation between funds and intended target audience i.e. unchurched people at certain event, discipleship program geared towards certain people in church, specific identified needs of community, etc.
- Justification for necessity of funds above and beyond church resources.
- A simple itemized list of expenses showing how grant funds will be dispersed.

THE PROCESS

- 1. Grant proposal is submitted to Rocky Mountain District "Grant Team"
- 2. Your proposal will be evaluated according to the guidelines outlined in this brochure.
- 3. Representative will contact submitting parties within 45 days of proposal with an approval or denial.
- 4. Denial will also include a simple written explanation of reasoning behind denial of grant proposal.
- 5. If you have an idea for a grant and don't know how to start, we can help you write a proposal.

THE GRANT PREFERENCE WILL BE FOR PROJECTS:

- Aligned with the continuing mission or vision of the church
- Creating lasting impact on the ministry of the church
- Accelerating or improving ministries the church is committed to
